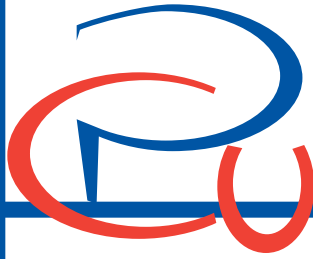

Credit Union Association Reaching Out to Veterans

Colorado credit unions are supporting a local effort with Homes For Our Troops (HFOT), a non-profit organization committed to building specially adapted homes across the U.S. for severely wounded American troops. HFOT will construct a home in Golden for wounded Iraq-war veteran Staff Sergeant Travis Strong and his family and present it to him around the Democratic National Convention in August. The house is being built at no cost to the Strong family and is a joint project of the Democratic National Convention Committee (DNCC), the credit union movement, and National Journal Group.

SSG Strong, age 30, is a double amputee, the result of injuries sustained during a rocket-propelled grenade attack on his Striker vehicle in November 2006. He was on his second tour of duty in Iraq for the U.S. Army. The home will be specially adapted for SSG Strong, his wife Misty, and their two children.

The undertaking marks a year-long series of service projects the DNCC has organized to give back to the community hosting the 2008 Democratic National Convention. Given its strong commitment to organized labor, the DNCC is proud to work closely with the Colorado Building and Construction Trades Council, AFL-CIO, which will provide skilled labor for the project in Denver.

The Credit Union National Association (CUNA) and its affiliated Credit Union Associations of Colorado and Wyoming (CUAC/CUAW) will work to raise funds, provide donated materials and volunteer labor, and coordinate activities closely with Homes For Our Troops. CUNA, the Minnesota Credit Union Network, and National Journal are also working with HFOT and the Republican National Committee on a companion project for a veteran's home in conjunction with the Republican National Convention.

Warning Signs of Telemarketing Fraud

"You must act 'now' or the offer won't be good"

"You've won a 'free' gift, vacation, or prize." But you have to pay for "postage and handling or other charges.

"You must send money, give a credit card or bank account number, or have a check picked up by courier." You may hear this before you have had a chance to consider the offer carefully.

"You don't need to check out the company with anyone." The callers say you do not need to speak to anyone including your family, lawyer, accountant, local Better Business Bureau, or consumer protection agency.

"You don't need any written information about their company or their references."

"You can't afford to miss this 'high-profit, no-risk' offer."
