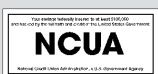

Scam Watch **Phony Fraud Alerts**

What is a phony fraud alert?

A phony fraud alert is similar to a phishing scam. It can come in the form of an email or a phone call claiming to be from your bank or financial institution. The scammer will usually tell you that your credit card or account has been cancelled because it was involved in criminal activity, or because they suspect your card or details have been stolen. This is a trick to get you to give them your account details.



Protect yourself from phony fraud alerts.

- Never send money, or give credit card or online account details to anyone you do not know and trust.
- Do not give out your personal, credit card or online account details over the phone unless you made the call and the phone number came from a trusted source.
- Do not open suspicious or unsolicited emails (spam). Delete them.
- Do not click on any links in a spam email, or open any files attached to them.
- Never call a telephone number that you see in a spam email.
- Never reply to a spam email (even to unsubscribe).
- If you want to access an internet account

website, use a bookmarked link or type the address in yourself. Never follow a link in an email.

- Never enter your personal, credit card or online account information on a website that you are not certain is genuine.
- Never send your personal, credit card or online account details through an email.
- Order your credit report every year to make sure no one is using your name to borrow money or run up debts.

If you think you have been targeted by a phony fraud alert, you should contact your bank or credit union to let them know. You can also report a scam to SCAMwatch.

Tell your friends and family about the scam so they know what to be on the lookout for if they are targeted.

Our partner, CO-OP Network promotes ATM locations that are well-lit and heavily trafficked.

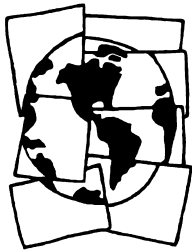

Power Credit Union Celebrates International Credit Union Day

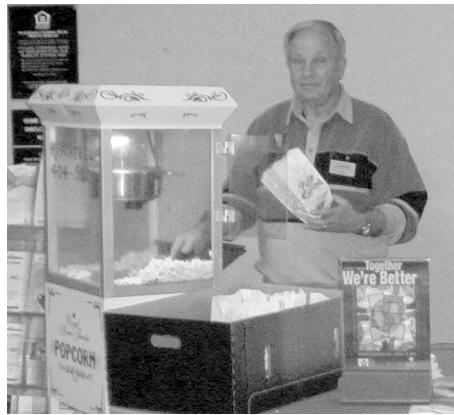
