Power Credit Union Announces New Branch Location in Trinidad, CO

Trinity Credit Union of Trinidad has been merged into Power Credit Union of Pueblo, the National Credit Union Administration in Alexandria, Va., and the Colorado Division of Financial Services announced Monday.

The Colorado Division of Financial Services had placed the troubled Trinity Credit Union into conservatorship on July 27 and appointed NCUA as conservator.

The merger occurred without assistance from the National Credit Union Share Insurance Fund.

The accounts of the new Power Credit Union members remain federally insured by the National Credit Union Share Insurance Fund up to \$250,000. Power Credit Union members will experience no interruption in services, officials said.

Power Credit Union is a state-chartered, federally insured community credit

union that opened in 1938. Before the merger, Power Credit Union had \$82.2 million in assets and nearly 11,400 members.

As part of the merger, Power Credit Union will maintain a branch in Trinidad.

Trinity Credit Union had nearly 1,200 members and about \$4.1 million in assets at the time of the merger. Chartered in 1939, Trinity Credit Union served the residents of Las Animas County.

NCUA is the independent federal agency created by the U.S. Congress to regulate, charter and supervise federal credit unions. NCUA operates and manages the National Credit Union Share Insurance Fund, insuring the deposits of more than 93 million account holders in all federal credit unions and the overwhelming majority of state-chartered credit unions.
